Water Quality Division Receives WaterReuse Award

Silverton's Public Works Water Quality Division received the Community Water Champion Award in recognition of the exemplary water reuse system developed and implemented at the Oregon Gardens. The award was presented September 10, 2018 at the 33rd Annual Symposium held by the WaterReuse organization which advocates for policies that increase the use of recycled water. Silverton provides treated wastewater to the wetlands that were constructed at the Oregon Garden. The water from the wetlands is used to irrigate the 220-acre botanical garden.
