III. AGENDA ITEM

3.1 Parks and Recreation Summary & Pocket Parks

Community Development Director, Jason Gottgetreu gave a presentation of the Recommended Action Plan for the Parks and Recreation Master Plan and gave a detailed update of the items on the list have been completed.

The current master plan does not recommend additional pocket parks, which are small parks of less than two acres in size. The smallest park type that the Master Plan recommends is a neighborhood park of 5-10 acres.

Other items discussed during the meeting include:

- The reason for pursuing parks and recreation district;
- The barriers to move forward on priority projects;
- Community survey update;
- Feasibility study for the trail master plan;
- Bike friendly study;
- DEQ-noise and trucks;
- Hobart on Webb Lake.

Community Development Director, Jason Gottgetreu gave a presentation on trees and the tree commission.

An updated street tree list was discussed and Commissioner Huebner reiterated the importance of the list for people who will be planting new trees following the loss of trees during the ice storm.
