## **Suspects Arrested After Robbery Incident**

At approximately 4:01am, Sunday, 10/11/20; Silverton Police Officers responded to 992 N. 2<sup>nd</sup> St. Apt. 23, to a report of home invasion robbery where gunshots had been fired. On Officers arrival, it was determined none of the tenants were injured and the three suspects had fled the area. The investigation revealed three suspects forced entry into the residence, where the tenant, who was armed with a firearm fired a shot. One of the suspects was struck and fled on foot. The other two suspects, one who was armed with a firearm, were able to disarm the tenant and fled with the tenant's firearm, firing shots as they fled. Shortly thereafter, Officers learned a subject had arrived at Silverton Hospital with a gunshot wound, which was not life threatening. This subject was stabilized and transported to a Portland Hospital. During the on-going investigation, Officers identified the suspects involved. At approximately 3:15pm, Officers had located the other two suspects and subsequently arrested them on the below listed charges and booked them into the Marion County Jail. The third suspect involved has not been arrested at this point, but has been identified, accounted for and not a threat to the community.

Arrested, charged and booked into the Marion County Jail were:

Aymard J. Camargo, 21yrs, (DOB: 05/18/1999), of Silverton. Charges: Robbery I, Unlawful Use of a Weapon, Menacing, Reckless Endangering & Theft I.

Tristan Norris, 20yrs, (DOB: 07/07/2000), of Silverton. Charges: Robbery I, Unlawful Use of a Weapon, Menacing, Reckless Endangering & Theft I.
