Date: 05-16-21 (Sunday)

21-2321 1406 Parking Silver Falls Dr.
The park host reported several vehicles parked in the fire lane at the reservoir. An officer responded and following an announcement over the PA system, the problem cars were all moved.

21-2322 1418 Welfare Check Cherry St.
A caller requested a welfare check on the resident at this location. Officers contacted her and found she was not in need of assistance.

21-2352 1131 Warrant Oak/Norway
