<b>General Position Summary</b>	Supervises employees and performs various water quality related duties necessary for the operation and maintenance of a class IV wastewater treatment plant, class III water treatment plant and city pool.
<b>Minimum Qualifications</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Two years of related post high-school education, such as an Associate’s degree in Wastewater Treatment, Water Environment, Water/Wastewater Technology, or a similar field, with seven (7) years of experience in a wastewater operation, two (2) of which are in a supervisory position; or any equivalent combination of the above education and experience.</li> <li>• Oregon Class IV Wastewater Treatment Certificate required</li> <li>• Possess valid Oregon driver's license or ability to obtain by time of appointment required</li> </ul>
<b>Desirable Qualifications</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Further education in a related field</li> <li>• Oregon Class II Water Treatment Certificate</li> <li>• Basic experience in Emergency Operations Center or small water/wastewater emergency management</li> </ul>
