- Prior to commencing work, all demolition and renovations are required to meet the State DEQ regulations regarding the handling and disposal of asbestos materials. This is a separate process. Contact the State DEQ Salem office at 1-8010-349-7677 regarding asbestos survey and abatement requirements. Information is also available online at: www.deq.state.or.us/aq/asbestos**
- Cap the sanitary sewer at the property line in an approved manner and call for an inspection from Silverton Public Works (503) 873-6359 prior to covering. If a septic tank is abandoned, a Septic Abandonment Statement is required.
- The applicant is responsible for disconnecting all utilities prior to commencing work.
- Additional permits may be required for decommissioning of underground fuel tanks.
- Unless other arrangements are made, the water meter will be removed.
- Applicant shall provide a statement that any hazardous material (i.e. asbestos) will be removed and disposed of properly. Any flood plain, riparian or creek related issues will also be addressed in this statement.
- Call for final inspection from City Building Department of the site when all debris has been removed. State DEQ approval must be obtained for burning of any material.
- If a basement is involved, describe proposed future use of lot and method of backfill and materials to be used.
- Any reconstruction on the site will be required to comply with the current development standards and permits (setbacks, parking, open-space, etc.)

I hereby certify that the above information is correct. Permits are non-transferrable and expire if work is not started within 180 days of issuance or if work is suspended for 180 days.
