CITY OF SILVERTON ORDINANCE 21-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE SILVERTON CITY COUNCIL APPROVING A ZONE CHANGE APPLICATION TO CHANGE THE ZONING OF 1459 PINE STREET FROM R-1, SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL TO R-5, LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL WITH A CONCURRENT PLANNED DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION TO CREATE 6 SINGLE-FAMILY DETACHED LOTS, A DESIGN REVIEW AND LAND DIVISION FOR 12 SINGLE-FAMILY ATTACHED LOTS, AND DEVELOPMENT OF PARKING FACILITIES AND RECREATIONAL AMENITIES WITHIN A TRACT, MARION COUNTY ASSESSOR'S MAP 061W34BB, TAX LOT 03200

WHEREAS, a zone change and planned development application (ZC-21-01 & PD-21-01) was made by North Willamette Valley Habitat for Humanity, PO Box 852 Mount Angel, OR 97362; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission met in a duly advertised public hearing on May 11, 2021 to consider the application, allowed testimony, and reviewed the application; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission reviewed the application and recommends the City Council approve the zone change and planned development as it meets the review criteria; and

WHEREAS, after proper legal notice, a Public Hearing before the City Council was held on June 7, 2021 to consider ZC-21-01 & PD-21-01. All interested parties participated and had an opportunity to be heard. The City Council reviewed all matters presented to it.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SILVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1: The City Council finds that the burden of proof for the Zone Change and Planned Development has been met and therefore the Zoning of 1459 Pine Street is changed from R-1, Single Family Residential to R-5, Low Density Residential and Planned Development application approved.
- Section 2: A full copy of the staff report and findings of fact can be found in file ZC-21-01 & PD-21-01, located in the Community Development Department at City Hall.
- Section 3: This ordinance is and shall be effective within 30 days of its passage.
