CITY OF SILVERTON ORDINANCE 19-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE SILVERTON CITY COUNCIL APPROVING A ZONE CHANGE APPLICATION TO CHANGE THE ZONING OF 811 SOUTH WATER STREET FROM R-5, LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL TO RM-10, MULTIPLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL.

WHEREAS, a zone change application (ZC-19-02) was made by Twilight Courts, LLC PO Box 311, Silverton OR 97381; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission met in a duly advertised public hearing on July 9, 2019 to consider the application, allowed testimony, and reviewed the application; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission reviewed the application and recommends the City Council approve the zone change as it meets the review criteria; and

WHEREAS, after proper legal notice, a Public Hearing before the City Council was held on August 5, 2019 to consider ZC-19-02. All interested parties participated and had an opportunity to be heard. The City Council reviewed all matters presented to it.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SILVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Council finds that the burden of proof for the Zone Change has been met and therefore the Zoning of 811 South Water Street is changed from R-5,

Low Density Residential to Multiple-Family Residential (RM-10).

Section 2: A full copy of the staff report and findings of fact can be found in file ZC-19-

02, located in the Community Development Department at City Hall.

Section 3: This ordinance is and shall be effective within 30 days of its passage.
