A RESOLUTION OF THE SILVERTON CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR PARKING

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to have all parking related fees listed in one resolution; and

WHEREAS, a fee schedule should be adopted in order to implement the fees as required under Chapter 10.08; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 16-25 a resolution establishing fees, and authorizing the year-round collection of parking fees at Silverton Maine Park shall be repealed; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 13-30, authorizing issuance of parking permits for on-street and certain city-owned parking lots for the parking of motor vehicles for a time or in a manner which would otherwise constitute a violation of the provisions of Chapter 10.08 and creating fees shall be repealed; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 18-12, adopting a fee schedule for parking shall be repealed.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SILVERTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the following fee schedule is hereby adopted:

STOPPING, STANDING, AND PARKING FEE SCHEDULE

Loading Zone Use Restriction Violations (10.08.024(C))	\$50 for each violation and for every two hours on the same date
Parking Permit and Meter Hoops (10.08.033)	\$25 deposit per hood \$5 daily fee per hood
Parking Methods Authorized Violation must be no more than 12 inches from curb, in direction of traffic (10.08.021)	\$10 for first offense
Meters – Legal Time Limit (10.08.030)	\$10 for first offense (meter expired) \$10 two hour meter violation \$25 after second offense (four hours at same two hour meter after initial violation) \$50 after third violation (six hours at same two hour meter after first and second cite issued)

Violation Notice Form Penalties (10.08.210(B))	After 14 days from the date of issue an additional fine of \$25.00 will be assessed for late payment. After 29 days an additional fine of \$50.00 will be assessed for late payment.																		
Violation Failure to Pay Fine (10.08.220)	\$50 administrative fee in addition to payment of all outstanding fines owed to the City.																		
Non-payment of parking fines	All non-payment of parking fines sent to collections will have a \$25.00 collection fee assessed.
