## CITY OF SILVERTON RESOLUTION 19-10

A RESOLUTION OF THE SILVERTON CITY COUNCIL TO DECLARE THE INTENT TO CHANGE THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY BY MEANS OF A WITHDRAWAL OF TERRITORY BY REMOVING 1355 SOUTH WATER STREET FROM THE CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, a request was made by Don Kelley on behalf of Rose Hope to remove 1355 South Water Street from the City Limits that was previously annexed; and

WHEREAS, the City Council must first adopt a resolution to initiate the withdrawal of the territory; and

WHEREAS, the legal description of the affected territory is attached as Exhibit 'A'; and

WHEREAS, the area proposed for withdrawal is described as follows:

Beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 4 of the Keeton Subdivision MCSR S26-004 said point being marked by a 2" Galvanized Pipe.

- (1) Thence South 20 30' West 162.36 feet;
- (2) Thence South 41 45' East 152.1 feet;
- (3) Thence North 36 10' East 147.84 feet
- (4) Thence N 41 45' West 210.66 feet to the point of beginning, containing 0.57 acres more or less

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SILVERTON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the withdrawal of the territory described above has been initiated.

Section 2: That this resolution is and shall be effective after its passage by the City Council.
