A RESOLUTION OF THE SILVERTON CITY COUNCIL TO TRANSFER FUNDS DUE TO UNFORESEEN EXPENDITURES TO INCREASE APPROPRIATION AUTHORITY TO PERFORM A TRANSIENT OCCUPANCY TAX (TOT) AUDIT

WHEREAS, Local Budget Law, ORS 294.463, authorizes the transferring of funds in these situations.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SILVERTON, AS FOLLOWS:
