AN ORDINANCE OF THE SILVERTON CITY COUNCIL APPROVING A ZONE CHANGE APPLICATION TO APPLY THE PUBLIC OVERLAY TO 907 RESERVE STREET WITH A CONCURRENT DESIGN REVIEW PERFORMANCE OPTION APPLICATION TO CONSTRUCT A NEW WATER TREATMENT PLANT. MARION COUNTY ASSESSOR'S MAP AND TAXLOT 061W35BD13300.

WHEREAS, a zone change and design review performance option application (ZC-21-03 & DR-21-05) was made by the City of Silverton 306 South Water Street, Silverton OR 97381; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission met in a duly advertised public hearing on February 8, 2022 to consider the application, allowed testimony, and reviewed the application; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission reviewed the application and recommended additions to the project and recommend the City Council approve the zone change and design review performance option as it meets the review criteria.

WHEREAS, after proper legal notice, a Public Hearing before the City Council was held on March 7, 2022 to consider ZC-21-03 & DR-21-05. All interested parties participated and had an opportunity to be heard. The City Council reviewed all matters presented to it.

met and therefore the Public Overlay District is applied to 907 Reserve Street

and Design Review Performance Option application is approved.
