**A RESOLUTION OF THE SILVERTON CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING JUNE 19<sup>th</sup> AS THE CITY HOLIDAY “JUNETEENTH NATIONAL INDEPEDENCE DAY”**

**WHEREAS**, the United States Congress passed and President Joseph Biden signed into law the Juneteenth National Independence Day Act recognizing June 19<sup>th</sup> as a Federally observed holiday; and

**WHEREAS**, the Oregon Legislature voted unanimously to recognize Juneteenth as a State of Oregon holiday; and

**WHEREAS**, the Silverton City Council desires to recognize and celebrate the emancipation of all Black Americans.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SILVERTON, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1: June 19<sup>th</sup> of each year is declared to be “Juneteenth National Independence Day.”


Section 2: Juneteenth National Independence Day is added to the City of Silverton Employee handbook as an observed as an observed Holiday
