WHEREAS, the Silverton City Council values input and recommendations for

WHEREAS, the Silverton City Council recognizes the importance of public engagement with historically underrepresented groups; and


WHEREAS, the Silverton City Council created the DEI Task Force to provide feedback on equity and inclusion in public processes, programs, decision making including, but not limited to, auditing current services and policies, exploring City events, and providing input on City spaces, and

WHEREAS, the DEI Task Force is made up of nine (9) members who are appointed to for two year terms,

WHEREAS, the Silverton City Council has reevaluated the number of members required for the DEI Task Force and determined that it can be reduced from nine (9) members to seven (7) members..


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SILVERTON that the number of members comprising the DEI Task Force is seven (7).
