A RESOLUTION OF THE SILVERTON CITY COUNCIL TO TRANSFER FUNDS DUE TO UNFORESEEN EXPENDITURES TO INCREASE APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE COST RELATED TO THE CITY MANAGER RESIGNATION AND RECRUITMENT PROCESS AND MEET ESTIMATED TRANSFER TO BUILDING IMPROVEMENT RESERVE FUND IN THE TRANSIENT TAX FUND.

WHEREAS, certain expenditures could not be foreseen such as the costs associated with the City Manager resignation and recruitment process through a third party and additional transient tax revenues; and

WHEREAS, Local Budget Law, ORS 294.463, authorizes the transferring of funds in these situations.


Section 2: That this resolution is and shall be effective after its passage by the City Council.
