Skate Park Rules

- This park is not supervised and all users of this park do so at their own risk.
- Park Hours: Sunrise to Sunset.
- Only skateboards, skates, scooters, roller blades, bicycles, BMX bikes are allowed for use in the park. No motorized vehicles or other wheeled objects are allowed.
- The park is to be kept clean. No food or drink is allowed on the Skate Park surface.
- Additional obstacles such as ramps and jumps are prohibited and not to be brought into the park.
- No alcohol, tobacco products, drugs, or glass containers are allowed in the park.
- All skaters are to be respectful of each other and surrounding park and city facility users.
- Loud noise or music is prohibited. Keep music volume at a level that neighbors and other park users don't complain.
- Vulgar, threatening, or abusive language is prohibited.
- Reckless, dangerous skating, and intentionally charging or colliding with other skaters is prohibited.
- Littering is prohibited. Skaters are to use trash containers provided and to sweep/keep clean the park surface when needed.
- The Skate Park is not to be used if hazardous conditions exist. Hazardous conditions exist if the surface is wet, icy, or if debris, litter, or other obstacles are on the surface.
- Parents and guardians are responsible for their children's safety and for ensuring that their children comply with the park rules.
- Helmets are required. The use of other protective equipment is recommended. These include but are not limited to knee pads, elbow pads, and wrist guards.
- Skaters should know their abilities and stay within them. Skaters should be prepared for the greater risks involved before attempting a more difficult area of the park.

Violation of any of these rules can result in temporary and/or permanent expulsion from the park.
